

ALMA Light at the Fuorisalone of Milan'2025

As part of the "Fuorisalone," taking place in the Brera district coinciding with Milan's Salone del Mobile, the exhibition "INSPIRED IN BARCELONA: LUCE" will be held. This vibrant tribute to Barcelona's lighting industry features more than 100 light fixtures that will highlight the potential of Barcelona's identity as the creative capital of the Mediterranean and Europe. The exhibition is organized by the Barcelona Creativity & Design Foundation and is supported by the Disseny Hub Barcelona (DHub) and Barcelona City Council, among other institutions.



From outside the exhibition center, a large light-up sign with the word "Barcelona" will welcome visitors. Inside, the installation will divide the lamps into three groups: the first will pay homage to the classics; the second will bring together projects that have become a product thanks to collaborations between designers and companies; and finally, the third will highlight the concept of "emerging design." ALMA Light is part of the second block with PotLight, the original table lamp in our current catalog designed by Josep Novell and Josep Puig.



At ALMA Light, we are delighted to have been invited to such a prestigious event, which reflects the current pulse of our city's design sector by uniting past, present and future in a single space. The exhibition, open to the public and curated by architect and designer Stefano Colli, will take place in the Sala Scalabrini of the Church of Santa Maria del Carmine (Via del Carmine 10, 20121 Milan, Italy) from April 8th to 13th, 2025.
