



The Chandelier in Gran Canaria



The Gran Canarian town of Gáldar is distinguished not only by its vibrant cultural activism but also by hosting an annual International Film Festival. In line with this interest, the city recently opened the Guaires Cultural Center, a former 1950s cinema that has been meticulously restored thanks to the initiative of the island's public institutions.



The renovation has managed to modernize the space without sacrificing its rich history, preserving its mid-century essence. Structural and decorative elements inspired by 1950, the year the former 'Cine Guaires' opened, have been carefully selected, thus paying visual homage to the refined and elegant style of that era.
