

The ecological material of Nonet collection

A few weeks ago we presented the Nonet collection of table lamps made with recycled materials. Today we would like to explain a little more in depth about the "Nonet Project", after which there were months of work with a large number of meetings, trialerror tests, different prototypes... until we found the appropriate material to make up the structure. The exciting path taken involved the R&D department of ALMA Light, the designers of the Ozestudi office and, most especially, the material supplier, the company Plàstic Preciós la Safor located in the province of Valencia, Spain.



Plàstic Preciós la Safor is dedicated, among other things, to innovating in the field of the circular economy to offer different solutions based on raising awareness about the benefits of recycling and maximum respect for the environment. The company regularly collaborates with the Association"Vertidos Cero", with the AIMPLAS Plastics Technology Institute and with more than 15 Spanish fishing ports, so the waste it processes comes mainly from marine garbage collected by fishermen and official recycling points. These plastics then go through crushing, extrusion, molding and machining processes in their own facilities until they become perfect PE sheets, with a very aesthetic finish, producing a 100% recycled, clean, useful, everyday, long-lasting product with a high degree of ecological awareness.



Returning to the Nonet collection, let us finish with specific data: the white Nonet table lamp is made with PE from 10% of DVD covers and 90% from packaging from the food industry, and the PE of the Nonet model in green comes 30% from marine litter and 70% from food industry packaging. Nonet definitely represents the maximum expression of sustainability, care for our oceans and respect for our planet.
